



MAINTENANCE OF PERMABOIS OILED WOOD FLOORS

PERMACLEAN SOAP: FOR REGULAR MAINTENANCE

It is made of soaps and oils (soy and coconut) emulsified in water. This soap cleans and nourishes the wood in the same step. It can be used for regular maintenance, every week or every two weeks. During the winter months, when relative humidity is at its lowest, the increased use of Permaclean on the floor will also reduce the possibility of cracking, splitting or chipping of the floor. This product is wax free.

Directions for use : Dilute one or two capfuls of Permaclean concentrate per 1 liter of water. Clean the floor with a sponge mop or a microfiber flathead mop completely wrung out. Let the floor dry without rinsing.

PERMALUSTRE DETERGENT: SPECIFICALLY ADAPTED FOR HEAVY TRAFFIC (TO BE USED 2 TO 3 TIMES A YEAR AS NEEDED)

It is made of soaps, oils (soy and coconut) and waxes emulsified in water. It cleans, nourishes and protects the wood. Avoid applying Permalustre too intensively because if the floors are not used intensively, there will be an accumulation of waxes on the surface.

Directions for use : dilute 1 part of PERMALUSTRE to 5 parts of water. Maintenance in combination with PERMACLEAN soap (frequency of use of PERMALUSTRE approximately every four months) Clean the floor with a sponge mop or a microfiber flathead mop completely wrung out. Let the floor dry without rinsing. Can be used in December as a preventive measure to nourish the fibers in preparation for winter and the expected dryness.

GREENOL : TO REGENERATE THE PROTECTIVE LAYER

After a few years of intense use, it may be recommended to apply a thin coat of GREENOL. Polish with a polishing machine equipped with a white disk. After application, let dry 24 hours.

WARNINGS :

- Equip the legs of your furniture with protective felts.
- It is recommended to vacuum regularly.
- Never wash your floors with water. Use a well wrung out mop
- Use our soap adapted to the finish of your floor: PERMACLEAN
- Avoid at all costs: detergents that are not compatible with oiled floors (Murphy, Sany, Hertel, etc.), wax or oil-based detergents for varnished floors, vinegar, steam mopping, heavy carpets with rubber film and intense natural or artificial light.

N.B.: Does not freeze! Products can be stored for at least 12 months in a cool dry place, in its original unopened packaging.
